NEW LUXURY SHOW HOME UNVEILED AS TOWNHOUSE COLLECTION LAUNCHED AT HOPE HOUSE

have honey coloured Bath stone exteriors and offer fantastic views of the surrounding countryside and the scheme's communal formal lawns, with landscaping by Matthew Wigan Associates.

The ground floor of the Park Row townhouse provides an open-plan fully fitted Leicht kitchen and dining area with a central island, leading to a comfy family living area

dressed with a smart grey sofa, a large feature rug and a marble-effect coffee table with gold accents. The kitchen has granite worktops and is fitted with integrated Miele and Neff appliances, with engineered timber flooring for a sleek finish.


The ground floor also provides a guest cloakroom, and a separate utility room off the kitchen area, providing ample storage space for a family. The open-plan living space

The Park Row property's first floor provides a large open plan living area centred around rich furnishings, with a pair of emerald green velvet sofas creating a warm, sophisticated living area. The first floor also provides a smart desk area, overlooking a large private terrace, which can be accessed through large folding French doors.

The property's second floor provides two guest bedrooms, both with their own en suite bathroom, offering flexible living space for the family or visiting guests. Bedroom Two can be used as a self-contained guest suite, with an en suite bathroom with a bath, as well as its own entrance and extensive private external patio. The show home's second bedroom is currently styled as a home office with a sofa which can convert to a bed, a desk and elegant wooden shelving, complemented by a range of house plants to provide a tranquil setting.

Bedroom Three continues the sophisticated interior scheme, featuring a large green velvet headboard, plush quilted throw and a dressing table, with lots of natural light coming from the south-facing windows.

The Park Row property's fourth floor is the grand master bedroom suite, continuing the elegant colour palette and plenty of natural light from its south-facing windows. The master bedroom is dressed in soft grey furnishings, with a tall feature headboard with gold stud detailing and a contemporary black chandelier. The master suite has

dressing rooms and master bathrooms. Hope House apartments also offer generous ceiling heights, up to 3.6 metres high, and original doors.

Beyond the two terraces the development forms a parkland setting containing a newly built main apartment building – called (along with the second terrace) the **Hope**Place Apartments – which has been designed as a sister to the original mansion. This main apartment building provides 17 one, two and three bedroom apartments.

Hope House has a rich history; originally the home of Charles Hamilton, son of the 6th Earl of Abercon, later becoming Bath High School where school where Mary Berry CBE learnt to cook, before being released for redevelopment in 1998. Hope House is centrally located with Bath city centre just 15 minute walk away and Bath Spa station a 20 minute walk away.
