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Approval for Timber Yard development scheme



Timber Yard

A development of 379 apartments in Birmingham's Southside district has been given the go-ahead by the planning committee at Birmingham City Council. The Timber Yard, a joint venture between Galliard Homes and Apsley House Capital, was recommended for approval by planning officers at the Council. Construction is expected to start on site later this year, with completion of the mixed-use scheme scheduled for 2021.

As well as providing a mix of one, two and three bedroom apartments, The Timber Yard - which will be built on a 1.58-acre car park site on Pershore Street, and bounded by Claybrook Street, Hurst Street and Skinner Lane - also includes circa 10,000 sq ft of ground floor commercial units for retail/leisure use. There are 95 secure parking spaces for residents.

Stephen Conway, executive chairman of Galliard Homes, said: "We're thrilled The Timber Yard is now one step closer to its groundbreaking. Birmingham offers great growth potential and with its lively cultural and social scene it's the perfect place for young professionals looking for a new home."
